Red Cross Volunteers Begin 7th Year of Serving Community

In January of this year, OESCo clients began their 7th year of providing valuable services to the American Red Cross. Although the team began with only two volunteers, the effort has grown to include two separate work groups and over 15 different clients. Both original OESCo volunteers continue to serve the Red Cross regularly.

At any one time, up to five OESCo volunteers work side-by-side with others from the community assembling the blood collection bags which are used across the region for blood drives. Another OESCo group works in the lab removing filtration devices from their wrapping.

In the last six months, OESCo clients



have logged 1,257 hours of volunteer time with the Red Cross. During these hours they completed 1,607 cases of blood bags, from which 4,821 products can be made. Red Cross warehouse

supervisor Denice McCarley proudly notes that all this work will touch 4.821 lives. These totals represent approximately 64% of the blood bags needed to supply the region (Portland, Vancouver, Salem, and Longview).

Kaiser Permanente expansion provides new opportunities: Last autumn, OESCo's Kaiser Enclave opened a new site at the Nicolai Service Center (NSC) in Northwest Portland with just one consumer. Now in its sixth month of operation, the NSC Enclave engages a total of eight clients who prepare lab results to be mailed for Kaiser Permanente's Health Connect department. Lab results from throughout the region are printed daily, and OESCo clients are responsible for sending out every single one — on average, 15,000 results per week! The development of this new site is another step in Kaiser's long history of providing employment opportunities for OESCo clients.
